**Changes in travel reimbursement
in the Czech Republic from
20 August 2022**

Changes in travel reimbursement in the Czech Republic from 20 August 2022

We would like to inform you that by Decree 237/2022 Coll. Ministry of Labour and Social Affairs of the Czech Republic, with effect from 20 August 2022, there are changes in selected basic compensation for the purpose of travel expenses reimbursement. The following rates are now valid:

Meal allowance

For each calendar day of business trip, employees are entitled to a meal allowance of:

1. **Business sphere:**
 - a) Min. CZK **120**, if the business trip lasts **5 – 12 hours**,
 - b) Min. CZK **181**, if the business trip lasts **more than 12 hours**, but maximum 18 hours,
 - c) Min. CZK **284**, if the business trip lasts **more than 18 hours**.

2. **State and contributory sphere:**
 - a) CZK **120 – 142**, if the business trip lasts **5 – 12 hours**,
 - b) CZK **181 – 219**, if the business trip lasts **more than 12 hours**, but maximum 18 hours,
 - c) CZK **284 – 340**, if the business trip lasts **more than 18 hours**.

The basic rate for the use of road motor vehicles

The basic rate for 1 km compensation for:

- a) two-wheeled vehicles and tricycles CZK **1.30**,
- b) motor vehicles CZK **4.70**,
- c) wagon, bus, tractor CZK **9.40**.

The average price of fuel

The average price for one litre of fuel under Section 158 (3) of the Labour Code is:

- a) CZK **44.50** for automotive gasoline 95 octane,
- b) CZK **51.40** for automotive gasoline 98 octane,
- c) CZK **47.10** for diesel,
- d) CZK **6.00** for electric car (for 1kWh).
